

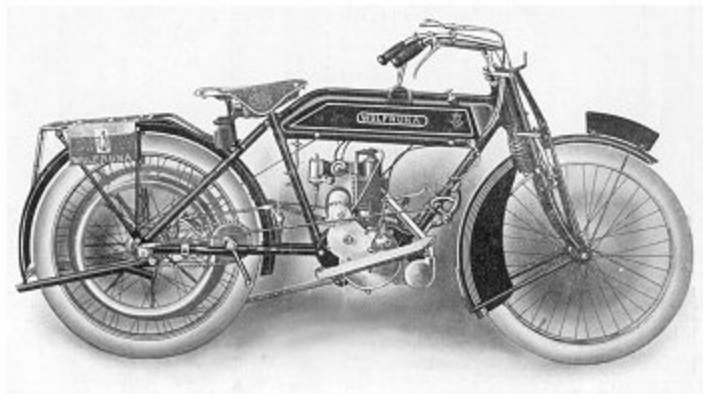

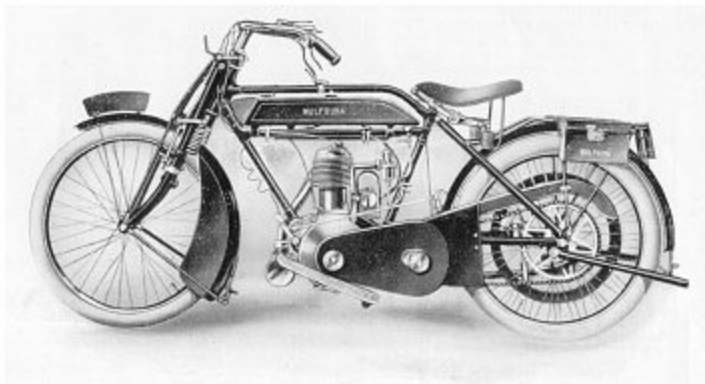

The Wulfruna 2.5h.p.

The 2.5h.p. machine was powered by a 2.5h.p. 2 stroke engine and had a senspray carburettor and Druid spring forks. The single gear version had a belt drive and sold for 32 guineas. The 2 speed version had a countershaft gearbox, chain and belt drive and was priced at 42 guineas. There was also a 3 speed model which was fitted with an Armstrong or Sturmey Archer gearbox, chain and belt drive and was priced at 40 guineas.

The 3.5h.p. machine had an A.M.A.C. or Brown and Barlow carburettor and Druid spring forks. The single gear version had a belt drive and sold for 43 guineas. The 2 speed version had a countershaft gearbox, chain and belt drive and was priced at 53 guineas. There was also a 3 speed model, which was fitted with an Armstrong or Sturmey Archer gearbox, chain and belt drive and was priced at 51 guineas.
